In Finland there has been clear direction during past 10 years. From several networks (NMT, paging, VHF) to only two technologies

GSM for private TETRA for authorities

There are 4 GSM networks for private customers And two TETRA networks for defined user groups





 VIRVE fullfills the obligations set by the Schengen Treaty

 Wide geographical area 350.000 km², sparsely populated with appr. 15 inhabitants per km²

Shared service for multiagency




Roll-out ready
