Enterprise Mobility Defined

- User: Superior usability and intuitive design. Access to information wherever you are, wherever you need it
- CIO/IT: Scalable, manageable and secure from infrastructure to devices.
- **Business Decision Maker:** A cost effective solution that meets the needs of business: Growth, productivity, competitive advantage



Mobility Behavior is evolving and will change more dramatically



- Mobile phones defined "Lifestyle" for consumer mobility and will define "Workstyle" for the **Enterprise**
- Workstyle merges voice, data, applications and personal life choices determined by the mobile enterprise user
- Work itself is becoming more mobile
- Mobile email currently a top management solution
- By 2005 over 60% of staff in Global 2000 will have mobile access to some corporate applications
- By 2007 more than 40% of corporate applications will have a mobility element

 - WiFi: corporate, home, hotspot
 Cellular based: GSM, GPRS, Edge, 3G, ...
 - device type

 - corporate desktop, laptop
 non corporate desktop, laptop, kiosk
 handheld smart phone, mobile phone,
 - **PDA**


