The MIDP Java application on the mobile device communicates over GPRS, CSD, or WCDMA to a Java Server Application compiling information requested by the subscriber. Through a Web interface, users create portfolios of stocks to monitor and receive tabular data on each monitored stock. They can also request live charts on major stock indices (Nasdaq, Dow Jones, STI, etc.) Whenever the MIDP-Java application is running, changes are automatically refreshed on the screen. News can be displayed as a ticker across the top of the chart.

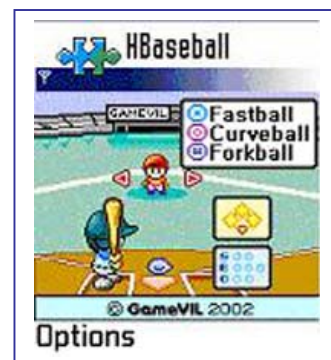

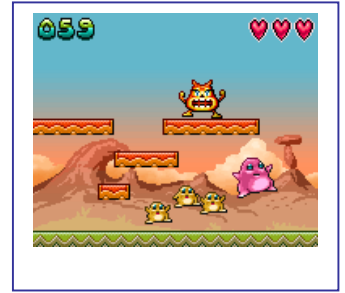
