SUPPORT GUIDE FOR TRANSFERRING DATA FROM OTHER PHONES TO THE NOKIA 9210 COMMUNICATOR

NOKIA

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1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this document is to help you to move information from another phone or Microsoft Outlook to the Nokia 9210 Communicator.

2. TRANSFERRING DATA FROM THE NOKIA 9110 COMMUNICATOR

The Data mover transfers data from the Nokia 9110 Communicator to the Nokia 9210 Communicator. Via infrared you can transfer, for example, contact cards, calendar events, notes and Internet access settings. You can either choose to transfer all data, or define the categories of data that you wish to transfer.

Open the Data mover in your Nokia 9210 Communicator; it can be found under the Extras application.

In the main view, press **Options**. A dialog with four pages opens.



On each page, press **Change** to select or unselect the data categories you wish to transfer to the Nokia 9210 Communicator. To select or unselect all items on a page, press **Select all** or **Unselect all**. To change the tab, press the **Menu** key. When you are ready, press **Close**.

To start the transfer process, press **Transfer now**. Activate the infrared connection on the Nokia 9110 Communicator when requested. After the infrared connection has been established, a dialog opens displaying the status of the whole transfer process.



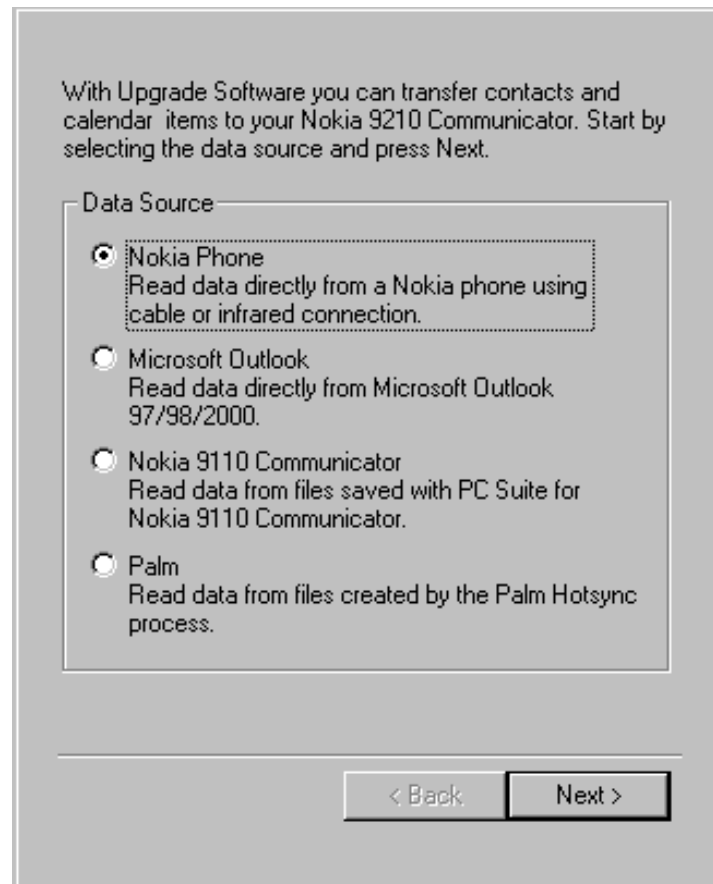
Note: Depending upon the selected options, this can take a long time. Ensure that both of the communicators are charged or that they are connected to their chargers for AC power during the transfer time. You can cancel the transfer process at any stage when the **Cancel** command button is available.

3. COPYING INFORMATION FROM OTHER NOKIA PHONES OR MICROSOFT OUTLOOK

The Upgrade Software (it is a plug-in for the PC Suite for Nokia 9210 Communicator) lets you copy the contacts or calendar information of your Nokia phone, Nokia 9110/9110i Communicator, or MS Outlook to your Nokia 9210 Communicator. You can find and install the Upgrade software from the CD-ROM provided in the Nokia 9210 Communicator's sales package.

The Upgrade Software is compatible with the Nokia 5100, 6100, 7100, 8200, 8800 series GSM phones, Nokia 9110/9110i Communicator and Microsoft Outlook 95/98/2000.

After installation, the Upgrade Software can be started by clicking the **Upgrade** icon in the left-hand frame of the PC Suite for Nokia 9210 Communicator, and selecting the transfer source. Proceed accordingly.



3.1 NOKIA PHONE



Note: Connectivity software for the phone from which the data is being transferred (like Nokia PC Suite or Nokia Data Suite), must be installed and configured first.

After selecting the Nokia phone as the data source, click **Next**.

Connect your phone, wait for the connection confirmation and select the data type to be transferred. The options are *Contact items* / *Calendar items*.

Click **Next** to start the transfer.

3.2 MS OUTLOOK

After selecting MS Outlook as the data source, click **Next**.



Tip: If you go back to MS Outlook to add folders before you start copying, click **Refresh** to update the folder tree view.

Select the Outlook folders containing the contacts or calendar data to be transferred. Click the + sign in the folder tree to view subfolders.

Click **Next** to start the transfer.

3.3 NOKIA 9110 COMMUNICATOR

Before using the Upgrade plug-in you must transfer the data from the communicator to the PC using PC Suite for Nokia 9110 Communicator.

1. From Nokia 9110 Communicator to PC

Start the PC Suite for Nokia 9110 Communicator and connect your communicator to your PC.



Note: If the PC Suite for Nokia 9210 Communicator and PC Suite for Nokia 9110 Communicator use the same communication port, you may have to exit the PC Suite for Nokia 9210 Communicator before starting the PC Suite for Nokia 9110 Communicator.

Click the **Import/Export** icon on the toolbar. The Import/Export application opens.

Select the data type.

Type a name for the file to be exported and browse for the location to which you want to copy the file. Keep a note of the file name and the location.

Click **Export**.

2. From PC to Nokia 9210 Communicator

Start the Upgrade plug-in. After selecting the Nokia 9110 Communicator as the data source, click **Next**.

Click **Browse** to locate the exported calendar and contacts files.

Click **Next** to start the transfer to the Upgrade plug-in.

Connect your Nokia 9210 Communicator to your PC. Wait for the dialog to confirm the connection. The dialog also shows the number of contacts and calendar items available for transfer.

Click **Next** to start the transfer to the Nokia 9210 Communicator.

4. **COPYING TELEPHONE NUMBERS FROM OTHER PHONES TO THE NOKIA 9210 COMMUNICATOR VIA SIM CARD**

Copy the numbers you want to move from another GSM phone to the SIM card. Follow the instructions in the phone's user manual.

Transfer the SIM card to the Nokia 9210 Communicator and replace the battery.

Open the contacts application.

Select the SIM card and open it.

If you want to copy all the contacts from your SIM card to the contacts database of the Nokia 9210 communicator, press **Ctrl + a** (copy all). You can also copy contacts one by one.

Press the **Menu** key and choose **More**. Now select **Copy to...**

Choose **Contacts** and press **Select**. Confirm the action by pressing **Copy**.
