



Quick Guide for Converting Contact Information from Nokia Data Suite 2.0 Format to Nokia Data Suite 3.0 Using the Nokia Database Converter.

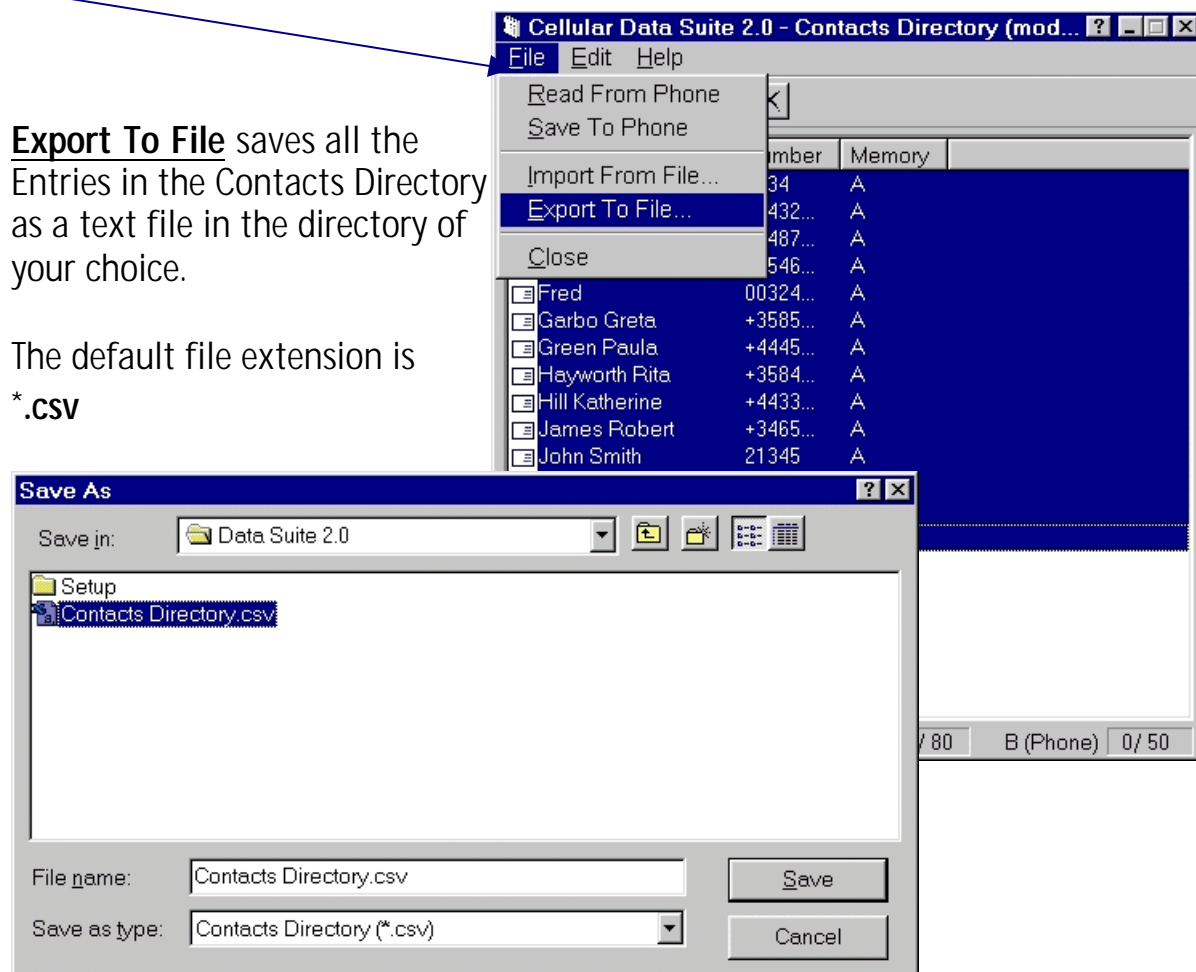
Note that if you have not yet installed the Nokia Database Converter on your Nokia Data Suite 3.0 folder you need to run the installation again. In the setup window click **Add/Remove...**

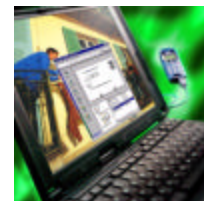
In the following window select **Nokia Database Converter** and then click NextNext

To save your contact information in Nokia Data Suite 2.0, select **File** and **Export To file**

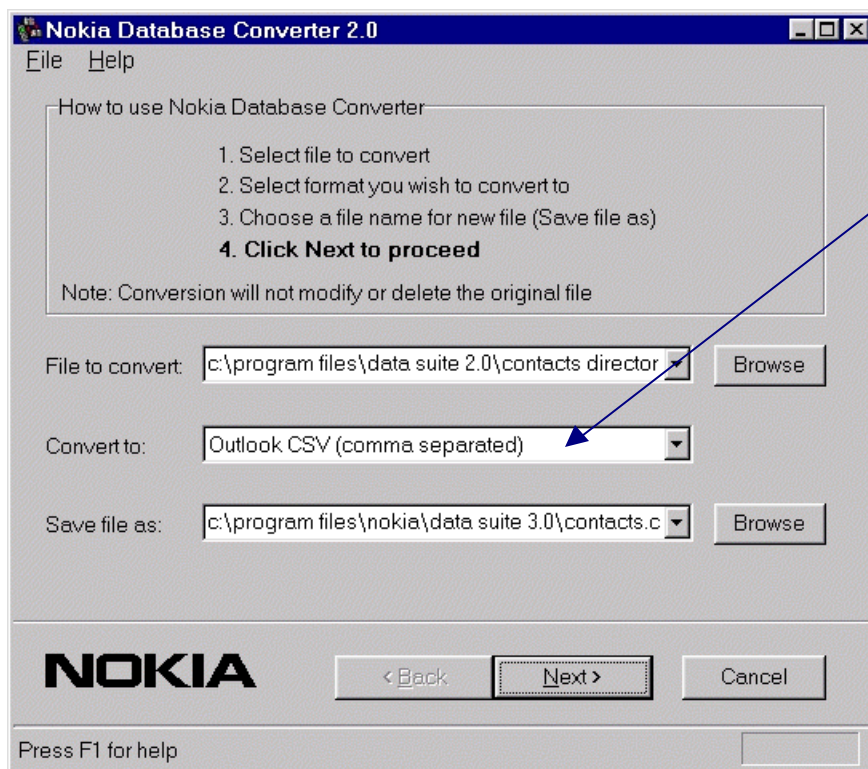
Export To File saves all the Entries in the Contacts Directory as a text file in the directory of your choice.

The default file extension is
*.CSV



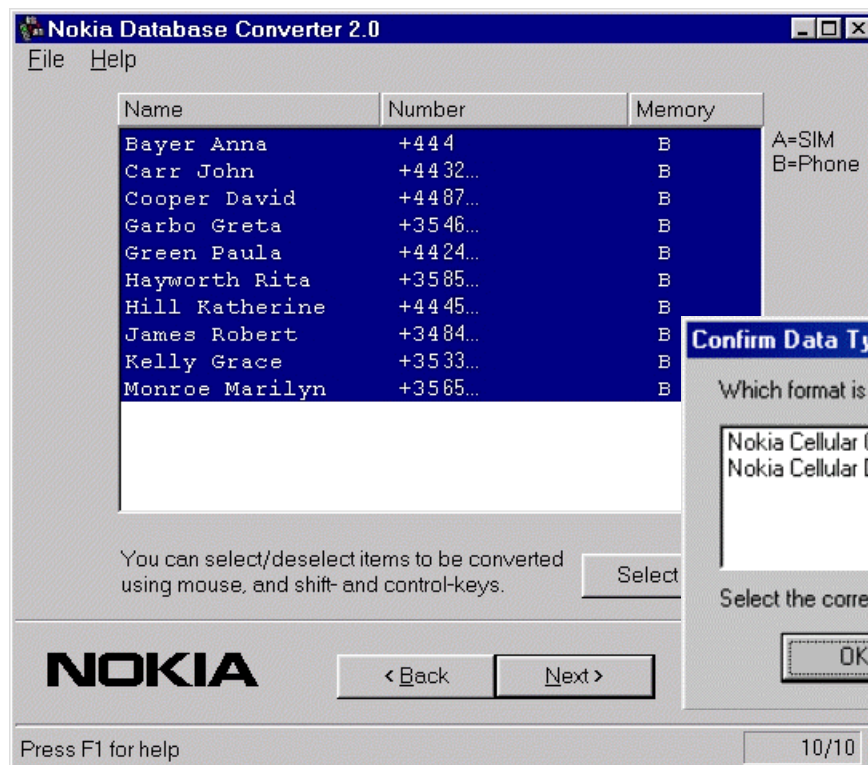


Open Nokia Data Converter and select the file to convert.

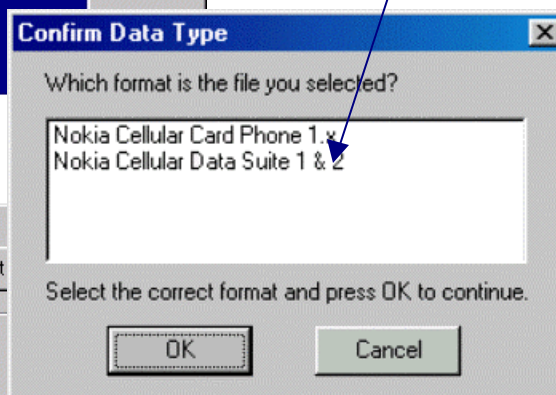


Select **Outlook CSV** format to convert the Nokia Data Suite 2.0 Contacts directory information file to Nokia Data Suite 3.0.

Click the Next button.

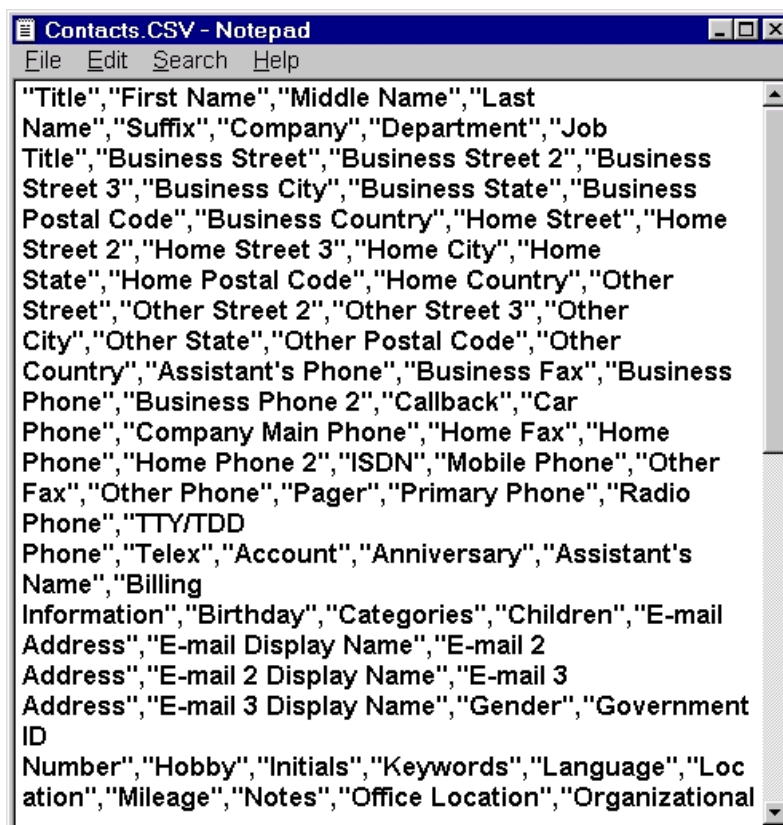
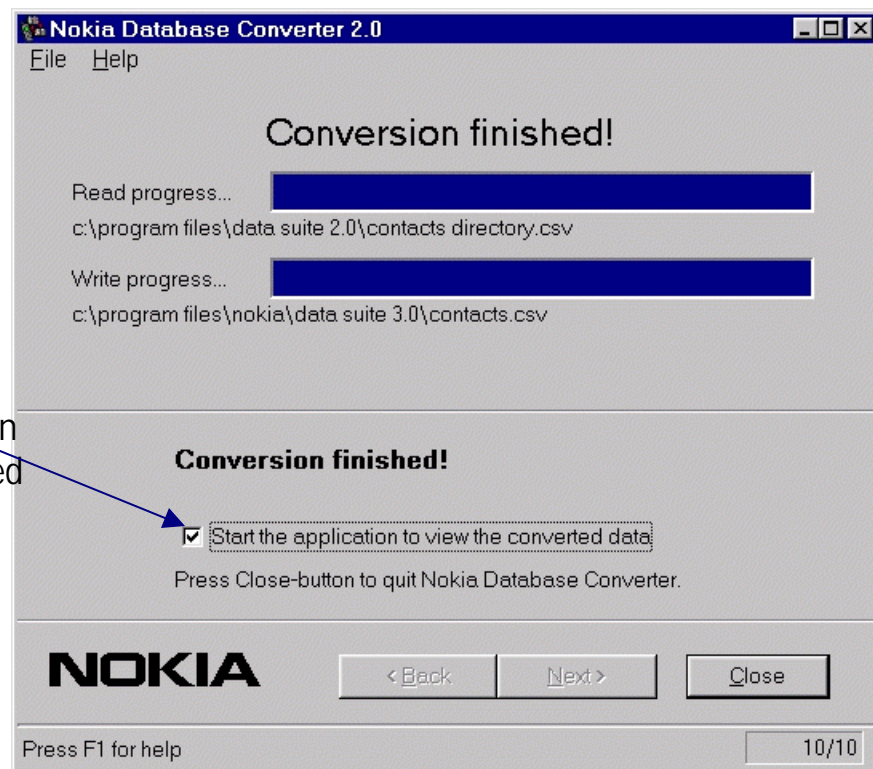


If you get a window as below select **Nokia Cellular Data Suite 1 & 2**.



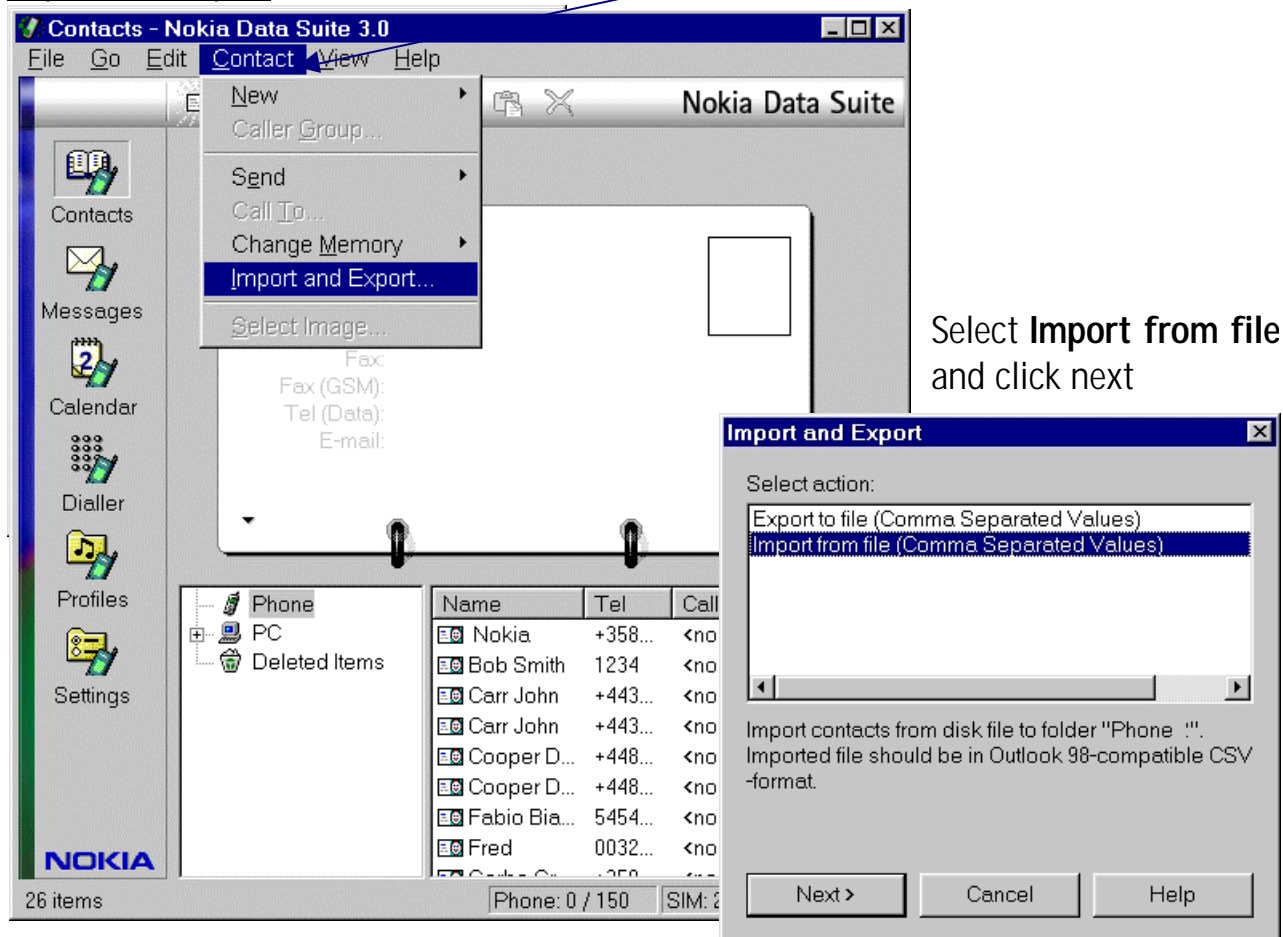


If you tick

below

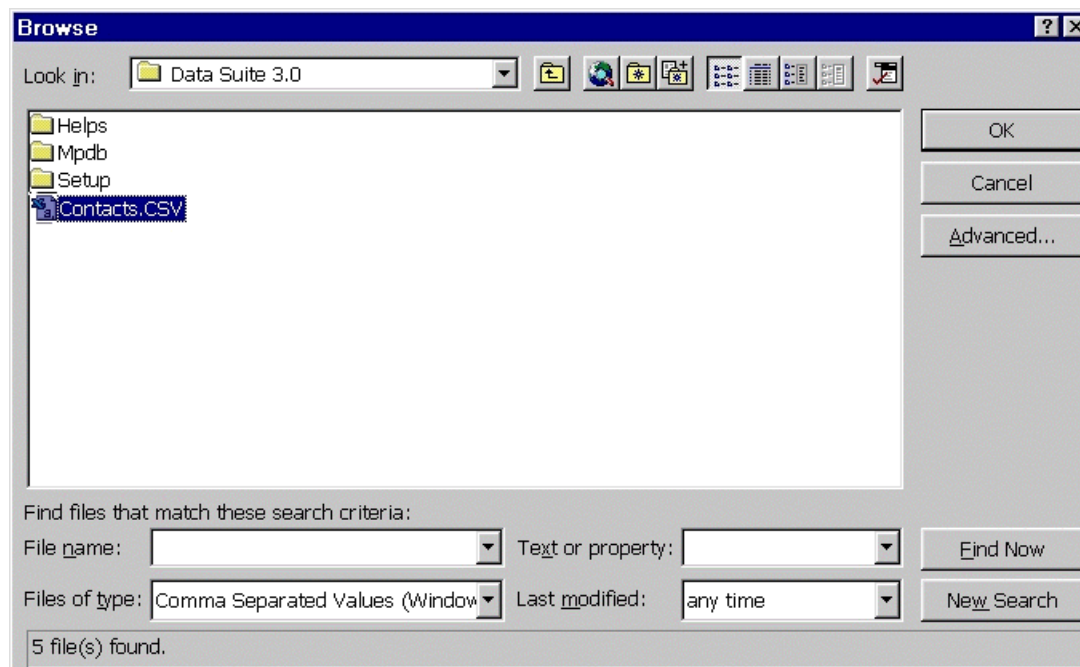




Start Nokia Data Suite 3.0, open **Contacts** and select **Contacts** from the menu and then **Import and Export**.



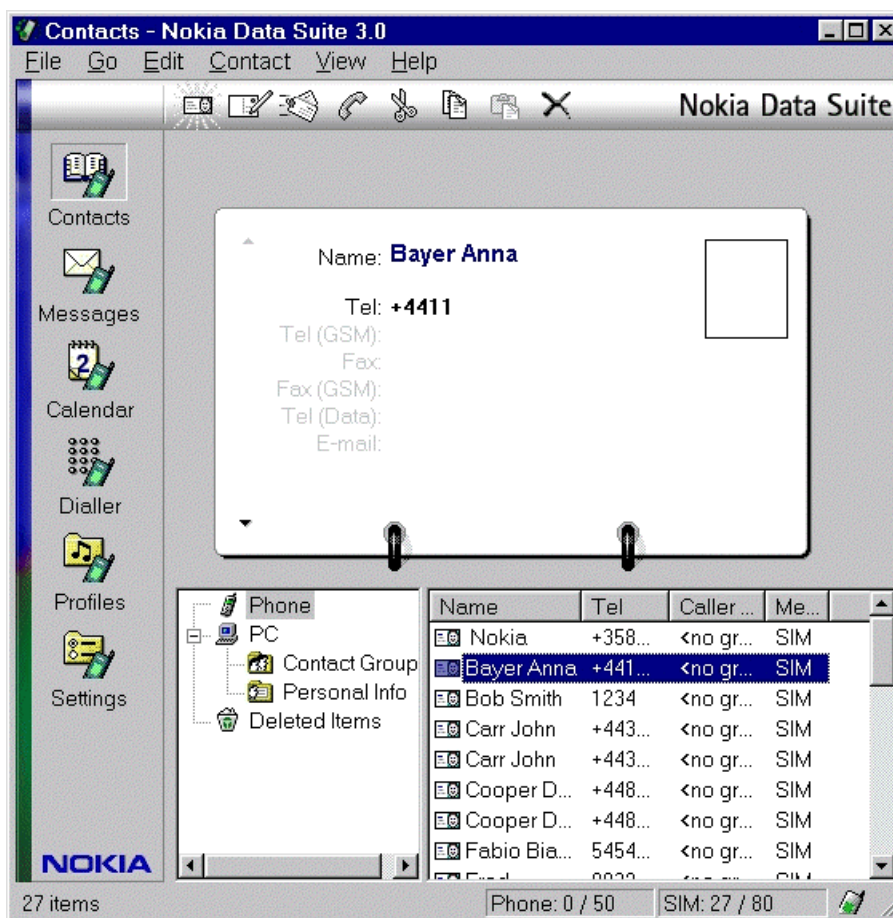
Select the name of the file that you want to import and click Open.

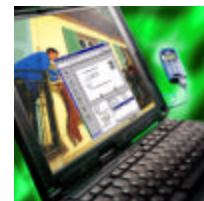

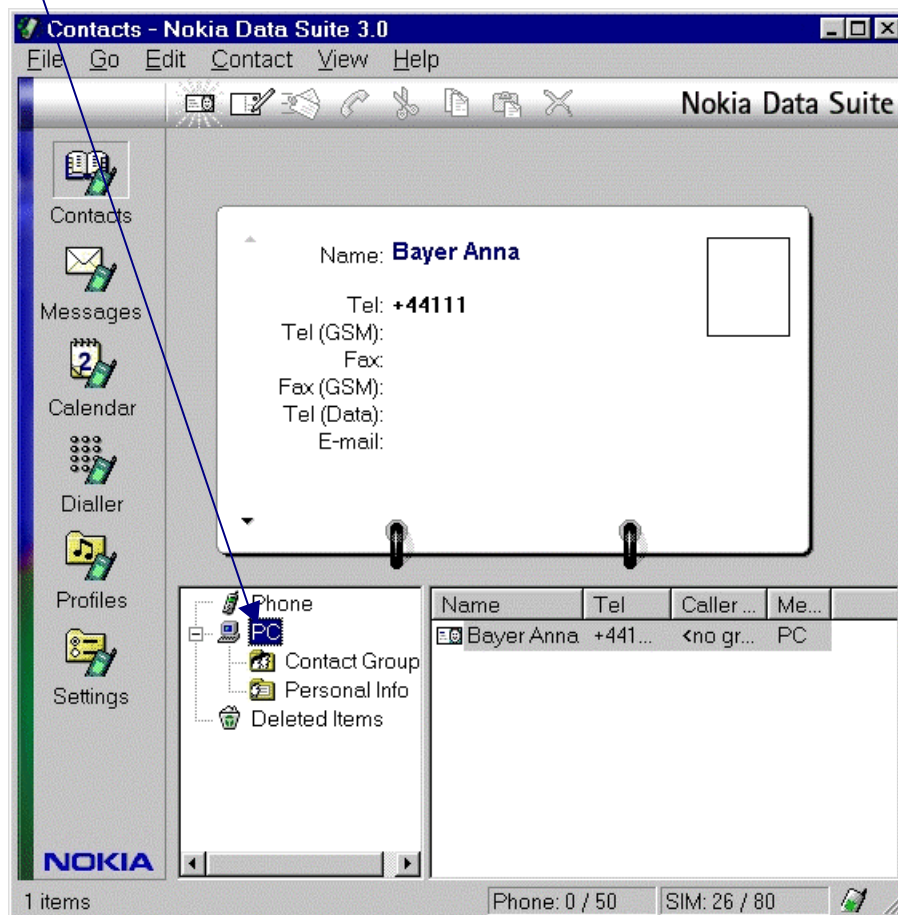


The Contacts' Entries imported from Nokia Data Suite 2.0 contain a **Name**, **Number** and **Memory** Type.
