






Quick Guide for Importing Contact Information from Nokia Data Suite 3.0 Format to Microsoft Outlook Contacts.

Open Microsoft Outlook or Schedule+ then activate Contacts and select File

and Import

and Export.





Choose Import from another program in the Import and Export Wizard window

and then click Next.












Note that if you want to import or export a file with a*.csv extension, you must have installed the Full version of Outlook.

Choose **Comma Separated Values (Windows)** in the Import a File window and then click Next.






Click Browse to find the file on your computer. Then select in Options how you



Select Contacts for the destination folder and click Next.




