




## THE QUICK GUIDE FOR MAKING A COMPUSERVE CONNECTION WITH THE NOKIA 9110 COMMUNICATOR

CompuServe is a widely used Internet access and service provider. This is a Quick Guide on how to make an Internet connection with the Nokia 9110 Communicator via CompuServe. Notice: a CompuServe Internet account is needed for CompuServe access. For further information about Internet access from the Nokia 9110 Communicator, see the Nokia 9110 Communicator User's Guide.



Please refer to the Communicator User's manual for instructions on operation, care and maintenance, including important safety information.

### Procedure for configuring the CompuServe connection

First, select the **Internet** application. Then, select **Settings** from the Internet application. After that, select the **Internet Access** and **Change** button from the Settings menu. Press the **New** button.

From the **Advanced settings** select the **Login customisation option** and press **Change**. Select **New** in the pop-up box. Type in the script below. Notice: the username and the password are provided by CompuServe.

The script must be typed to the editor as it is written in this document.

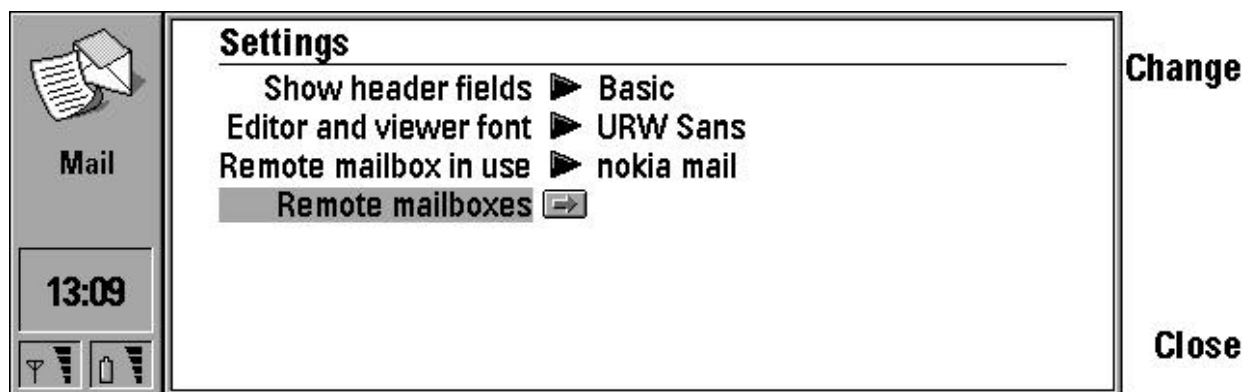
After typing the script press **Close** and type in the script's name, e.g. CompuServe.

Highlight the used **Login customisation** and press **OK**. Return to the first Internet menu by pressing **Close** four times.

## Procedure for filling in the Compuserve's mail settings on the Nokia 9110 Communicator

You can use the POP3 server for the mail settings. Usually the domain name for CompuServe is csi.com. The settings are provided by the CompuServe provider.

First, select the **Mail** application from the Internet menu. Press the **Settings** button and highlight **Remote mailboxes** and press **Change**. Press **New** and fill in the following data.



**Remote mailbox name:** your mailbox address assigned to you by your provider

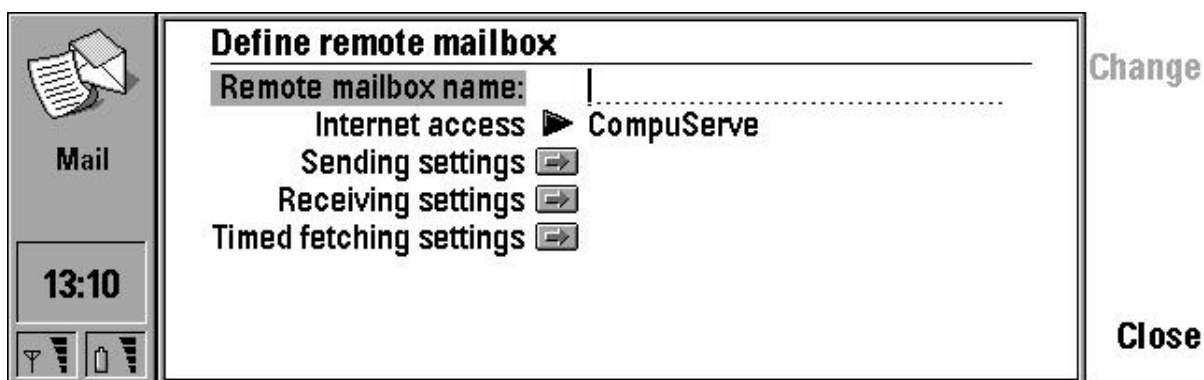
**Internet access:** CompuServe

**Sending settings:**

Your e-mail address  
Sending host

**Receiving settings:**

Your CompuServe username  
Your CompuServe password  
Receiving host  
Remote mailbox protocol: POP3



After entering the information above press the **Close** button five times. Now the CompuServe Internet access is ready to be used in the Nokia 9110 Communicator.
