
Quick Guide For Using The Nokia 9110 Communicator as a FaxModem via serial port cable



The communicator may be connected to a computer via an infrared or cable connection. The connection type is selected in the communicator's Fax modem settings (the Fax modem application is found in the System main view).

Fax modem installation using a cable connection:

- 1) Start Windows 98 and switch on the communicator's phone interface.
- 2) Insert the Setup disk into the disk drive of your computer. This floppy disk contains the modem information file. Alternatively the .inf file is available at the www.nokia.forum.com communicator pages.
- 3) Connect one end of the cable DLR-2 to the adapter and the other end to the serial port of the computer.
- 4) Double-click Modems icon in the Control Panel. Click the Add button in the Modems Properties Dialog.




- 5) Choose "Other" to the Question "What type of modem do you want to install?". Click Next button.
- 6) Tick the option "Don't detect my modem; I will select it from a list." Click Next button.







8) Copy manufacture's files from A:\






10) Choose the serial port to which the cable DLR-2 is connected. Click Next button.




11) Click Finish button.
