Modem Setup for Nokia 6250 Quick Guide

Modem Setup for Nokia 6250 will install the following components on your computer:

- Nokia 6250 data and fax modem adapters which enable you to use your phone as a modem in data and fax calls
- Nokia Modem Options which enables you to set options for the data calls you
 make

Modem Setup for Nokia 6250 runs with Windows 95/98, Windows 2000 and Windows NT 4.0 with Service Pack 3 or newer.

Installing Modem Setup for Nokia 6250

- 1. Once you have downloaded the installation file (ModemOptions.exe), go to the directory where you downloaded the file and double-click it.
- 2. Follow the instructions on the screen.

In the **Select Action** window you are prompted to select the connection type: you can select the infrared link (provided that your computer has infrared capabilities), cable connection or both.

Note: The Nokia 6250 data and fax modem adapters will be installed automatically during the setup.

Selecting Your Phone as a Modem

You can use your phone with a variety of commercially available data and fax communications applications. When configuring a data or fax application, you must select your phone as the modem. Depending on whether you want to use the connection cable or an infrared connection, you can select either **Nokia 6250 Cable** or **Nokia 6250 IrDA** as the modem.

Starting Nokia Modem Options

You can start Nokia Modem Options from the Control Panel: Click the **Start** button, point to **Settings** and click **Control Panel**. In the Control Panel, double-click **Nokia Modem Options**.

You can change data call settings even when your phone is not connected to the computer. Please refer to the Nokia Modem Options Help for information on how to set these options.

Uninstalling Modem Setup for Nokia 6250

- 1. Click the **Start** button, poin to **Settings** and click **Control Panel**.
- 2. Double-click **Add/Remove Programs**.
- 3. In the Install/Uninstall tab, select **Modem Setup for Nokia 6250** from the list of software that can be removed.
- 4. Click Add/Remove.
- 5. Follow the instructions on the screen until the program files are removed.

Important safety notes

All the safety instructions in the user's guides of your phone and computer also apply when this product is used with the phone.

Remember to make backup copies of all important data to protect against possible loss or alteration

Do not point the infrared beam at anyone's eyes or allow it to interfere with other infrared devices.

To disconnect the cable from the phone, hold the connector and remove the cable.
