




Quick Guide For "How to achieve a data speed of 14 400 bps using Nokia Data Suite 3.0"

First, you must have Nokia Data Suite 3.0 installed on your PC and have subscribed to the 14.4 kbit/s data transfer service.



Connect the phone to the PC using the DAU-9P connection cable supplied with Nokia Data Suite.

Click Get Status.

The current data speed will be shown in the Status field.

- Click the data speed you require.
- Click OK to save the changes and exit the program.

If you selected the 14.4 kbit/s data speed, remember to configure the modem settings.

Quick Guide for Configuring the Nokia Data Suite 3.0 Modem Settings for 14 400 bps Data Speed

1. Click the Start button, point to Settings and then click Control Panel.
2. In the Control Panel window, click Modems.
3. In the Modem Properties window, General tab, select "Nokia GSM Data 3.0" and click Properties.
4. In the Nokia GSM Data 3.0 window, Connection tab, click Advanced.
5. In the Advanced Connection Settings window, type the correct form of the AT+CBST command in the Extra Settings box:

If you use a standard phone line, type AT+CBST=14

If you use an ISDN connection, type AT+CBST=75

If your network speed varies between 9.6 kbps and 14.4 kbps, type AT+CBST=0
(Please contact your operator)

Click OK.
